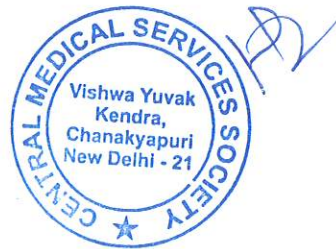

We would like to draw your kind attention to the fact that LLIN manufacturing capacity is still limited, this is evident as of following: - Bidders requesting for an extension of supply period from 90 to 120 days and from 120 to 150 days for Lot 1 and 2 respectively. - Historically, LLIN supplies have always been delayed by suppliers and this is evident from the fact that almost all LLIN supplies in the past were subject to delayed delivery or LD Charges. - As per procurement guidelines issued under circular number No. P-45021 /2/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 16th September 2020, any purchase above INR 200 Crore can be open to Global Tendering provided the local supplies are constrained. - LLIN manufacturing capabilities for the 2 local suppliers are stretched and the probability of completing deliveries within the stipulated period are bleak. - We would request you to open this tender for Global Competitive Bidding, as this would allow for: Faster delivery of nets Ensure more competition, which is currently limited to 2 suppliers only. Ensure better pricing and quality for nets. The delayed delivery of nets impacts the distribution plans of the National Malaria program and once the transmission season is missed, the expected disease impact / reduction in cases would not be achieved. This is a serious issue that needs to be addressed by ensuring timely supplies, which is possible if more competition is allowed in the current tender.	No Change

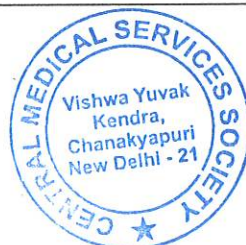

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			consider gently stretching the fabric with maximum of 1 kg or 10 newtons while measuring the dimensions during the PDI. <i>Please note that the LLIN fabric shrinkage due to hydraulic power compression is not permanent and the LLIN fabric will get back to its original size when stretched.</i> c) Dimensional Stability: The dimensional stability specified in the tender is 5% shrinkage and expansion in both directions. This is very low considering the nature of the LLIN fabric and moreover it is not in-line with WHO and international standards. This specification requirement again will contribute to additional cost unnecessarily. The WHO specification for dimension stability of LLIN product is not more than 10% shrinkage and not more than 5% expansion in both directions. Attached, please find the supporting documents: 1. WHO Pesticide Manual for Pesticide Specifications for LLIN (Page 5 of 9). 2. WHO Specification 454/LN/2 (Page 9 & 10 of 51). d) Wall and Top joints: <i>"The top shall be made from single piece of netting for all sizes of mosquito nets. The walls shall be made from one piece of netting and shall be closed with lapped seam and the seam shall be at one of the corners. One edge of the netting of the wall shall be attached to the netting at the top by means of a plain seam."</i> The above specification for "Wall and Top" specifies that the top and walls should be made from a single piece of netting. While this requirement is possible but comes at a very high cost to the environment, significant reduction in the production capacity and ultimately increasing the cost of the LLIN without adding any value to the buyer. It is to be noted that this issue of Wall and Top joints along with Initial Dimensions, Measurement of Size and Dimensional Stability were represented up by the international LLIN manufacturers to the major LLIN procurement institutions such as WHO, The Global Fund, UNICEF, UNHCR, PSI, The Red Cross and USAID by providing sufficient evidence and after thorough research into the general textile production capabilities and outputs.	c) Technical specifications shared by program division to followed strictly. d) Technical specifications shared by program division to followed strictly

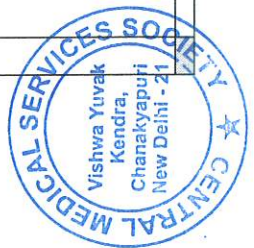
