The drug is initially packed in a white high-density polyethylene (HDPE) bottle with child resistant polypropylene (PP) closure with induction seal her and each HDPE bottle shall contain 30 tablets of Pretomanid -200mg. 144 such HDPE bottles would be further packed in white coloured Millboard/Grey board boxes and ultimately packed in a 5-Ply Shipper.

AMENDED TO BE READ AS:

The drug is initially packed in a white high-density polyethylene (HDPE) bottle with child resistant polypropylene (PP) closure with induction seal her and each HDPE bottle shall contain <u>26 tablets</u> of Pretomanid -200mg. 144 such HDPE bottles would be further packed in white coloured Millboard/Grey board boxes and ultimately packed in a 5-Ply Shipper.

Companies who have experience in manufacturing and getting the product prequalified by WHO, have 36-month shelf life. Thus, request you not to compromise with the standard of the product.		
4	Refer to Clause: - SECTION VIII: SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT - Point # GCC 8.7.5 (Page # 137 of 185):	The contractor shall ensure that at least 5/6th of shelf-life remains balance on delivery date.	Please refer to this condition; instead of 5/6th (83%), we ask that the consignee be given a minimum of 75% shelf life at the time of delivery for Sch I. As because our shelf life for Sch I Pretomanid is 36 months, even if remaining shelf life is 75% still the product shelf life will have 27 months RSL which is still convenient for patient. We manufacture in lots at once, and it takes time for those batches to be released, followed by PDI and further dispatches post CMSS's clearance. Because of this drawn-out process, approximately one-fifth of the shelf life is lost. We assure CMSS to dispatch the goods from fresh production only. However, as the goods are required in multiple tranches, in the cases of left over quantity due to batch size or batch yield from Tranche I that we plan to allocate in Tranche II, while waiting for remaining quantity of Tranche II to get produced, the RSL of these small quantities may get below 5/6th.
