The medical device shall conform to the standards laid down by the Bureau of Indian Standards established under section 3 of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 1985 (63 of 1985) or as may be notified by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare in the Central Government, from time to time. 2. Where no relevant Standard of any medical device has been laid down under sub-rule (1), such device shall conform to the standard laid down by the International Organisation for Standardisation (ISO) or the International Electro Technical Commission (IEC), or by any other pharmacopoeial standards. 3. In case of the standards which have not been specified under sub-rule (1) and sub-rule (2), the device shall conform to the validated manufacturer's standards. We humbly request CMSS to kindly consider the inclusion of a valid Market Standing Certificate (MSC) issued by the Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO) as part of the eligibility criteria for Schedule II. The Market Standing Certificate issued by CDSCO is a critical regulatory document certifying that the manufacturer/importer and the concerned products are duly licensed, legally marketed in India, and are in good regulatory standing, with no adverse regulatory actions or violations under the Drugs & Cosmetics Act and the applicable rules. Inclusion of this requirement would further strengthen regulatory compliance, ensure product quality assurance, and safeguard patient safety – key objectives of public healthcare procurement. We, therefore, humbly request CMSS to kindly examine and consider inclusion of the Market Standing Certificate (MSC) from CDSCO in the eligibility conditions for Schedule II of the tender, in the larger interest of quality, compliance, and public health. Further, the Purchase Order will be issued by CMSS on the basis of actual requirement of items & as per terms & conditions of Rate Contract.
4.			2. Last time in NACO dispatch, we were facing a space issue in most of the delivery locations. There was no space to unload the material. So, they did not allow trucks for unloading. Due to this, we also paid extra charges to transporter for such delay.	M/s MHL Healthcare Ltd	Clarified as: The suppliers to intimate in writing to the consignees well within time (at least two weeks prior to dispatch) so that the required space can be created in the warehouses of State AIDS Control Societies. Suppliers will be provided with all the consignee details (email IDs, contact numbers and consignee address) and the same to be utilized for timely communication to the desired locations. Any issues related to the delivery of the consignment to be raised within timely manner with the CMSS for immediate coordination with NACO for its resolution.
